West Michigan II Ski Patrols are hosting the largest ski and snowboard swap in Michigan. The 45th annual sale is set for November 4-6 at Cannonsburg Ski Area, 6800 Cannonsburg Road.

Cannonsburg, Pando, and West Michigan Nordic Ski Patrols use commissions earned from the sale to purchase first-aid supplies and life-saving equipment used to evacuate injured guests in the event of an accident or emergency. The ski patrol has a new department for year-round outdoor sport items. The all-volunteer ski patrols do not receive any governmental funding. Don't miss your chance to sell or buy from the terrific selection of new and gently used skis, snowboards, accessories, and apparel for all winter activities at hugely discounted prices. Equipment and gear from multiple retail stores and public sellers will be available on a first come, first served basis.

Hours are Friday November 4 from 10 am to 8 pm, Saturday November 5 from 10 am to 6 pm, and Sunday November 6 from 11 am to 2 pm. Experienced skiers, snowboarders and equipment personnel will be available to help with fitting and purchase decisions.

Check-in for items to be sold in this year's sale will be at Cannonsburg Ski & Ride Area from Monday through Wednesday, October 31 and November 1-2 from noon to 7 pm. Not accepted are straight skis, older bindings, or damaged equipment. Equipment will be inspected for safety.

Cost to register items to sell is \$2 per 5 items. There is a 25% commission for each item sold. Proceeds will support the three non-profit ski patrols for supplies and equipment to help hundreds of injured skiers and snowboarders each season.
